## HAZARDOUS WASTE

NEVER goes in the bin

You must NEVER throw hazardous waste into your household bin. Hazardous waste should always be disposed of in a safe manner.

Examples of hazardous waste are:

- Batteries
- Energy Saving Light Bulbs
- Chemicals
- Paint
- Spray Cans
- Nail Varnish Remover
- Leftover Perfume
- Descaling Products
- Thermometers

There are several ways of disposing of hazardous waste safely:

1. The Recycling Center
2. Hazardous Waste Box (if you have your own bin)
3. Caretaker Agreement (if your apartment building has one).
